## FOOD MICROBIOLOGY PROFICIENCY TESTING SCHEMES

### Terms and Conditions of Participation

1. Samples distributed as part of the Schemes may contain microbiological pathogens of Hazard Groups 1 and 2 as defined by the Advisory Committee on Dangerous Pathogens (2004) "The Approved List of biological agents". Participants must ensure that their laboratory facilities and expertise are adequate to ensure the safe handling of these organisms during their participation in the Schemes.
2. PHE reserves the right to decline renewal of participation in the Scheme.
3. Participation in the Scheme is offered with the understanding that participants will process quality assessment samples in the same way as their routine samples. This is necessary to achieve the primary purpose of the Schemes, which is to allow participants an insight into their levels of performance in routine work.
4. Each laboratory will be registered under a unique code number. This code number and the assessment of individual performance is confidential to the participant and will not be released by PHE to third parties other than under any written agreement. Participants are free to release information concerning their own individual performance to whoever they wish. The fact of actual participation in the Schemes is not regarded as confidential and may be revealed by PHE to those with legitimate reasons for knowing.
5. All reports, and the data they contain, issued by PHE are Copyright of PHE and may not be published in any form without permission of PHE.
6. Participants in the Schemes have entire responsibility for all samples distributed to them under the Scheme and all activities carried out by them or any third party in relation to the samples from the time of delivery of the samples.
